

Buñol is an inland town, just 30 km Valencia. Its geographical location, between mountains, provides it with natural landscapes of great beauty, all of which have water as a common element. In addition, it offers a series of monuments and places of great historical and cultural recognition throughout the town centre. Buñol is world famous for La Tomatina and has much more to offer: a unique town with a very peculiar idiosyncrasy that you cannot miss.

WHAT CAN YOU DO IN BUÑOL?

HERITAGE

CASTLE OF BUÑOL

Buñol Castle is one of the best preserved castles in the Valencian Community and one of the few in Spain with dwellings inside that are still inhabited today.

Accessed from the upper part, through the central tower, we find the Plaza de Armas. where most of the houses are located between two side towers that border the square. A bridge, with impressive panoramic views of the town, leads us to the lower part, where we can identify the most significant elements: the Main Tower. the Archaeological Museum located inside the Manor House, the Ethnographic Museum located in the old Church of El Salvador. In the lower part, the South Tower gives us access to the Castle quarter. which leads us into a network of narrow streets of Muslim origin that lead to small squares with whitewashed walls, which make up a mosaic of houses that seem to

This neighbourhood has served as inspiration for famous painters such as Sorolla, who painted some of its streets.

GALÁN MILL

support the Castle craq.

It is an example of factory heritage and symbol of the importance of the paper industry in the municipality.

This type of building is typical of the paper mills of Buñol and is intended to emulate domestic and constructions. Nowadays it has been refurbished and its floors are used for different purposes: Municipal Library. Museum of La Tomatina and exhibition rooms.

The river Buñol runs next to the Molino Galán, which connects with the River Park and serves as a recreational area and connection to the natural environment: in summer you can enjoy a swim in its natural pools.

PARK OF SAN LUÍS

The park is home to the neo-Gothic style Hermitage of San Luís Bertrán, built in the 18th century. Apparently, the present hermitage replaced a much older one in the same place. which was totally ruined by a flood. According to tradition, in the 16th century San Luís Bertrán marched from Valencia to Buñol on foot to evangelise the abundant Moorish population of Buñol.

During his stay he slept on the ground of this walkway, hence its name. Within the promenade we also find the open-gir Municipal Auditorium, where the town's musical concerts are held in the spring and summer months.



NATURE

BUÑOL RIVER

Startina from the Paseo de S. Luis, we can ao on an interestina excursion that will take us to the pools carved out of the rock known as La Jarra.

From La Jarra we reach the Natural Bridge - Carcalín Ravine. A route of aeological and scenic interest, which will allow us to practice activities such as climbina. canyoning and hiking.

FLUVIAL PARK

A pleasant walk through a modern park that has allowed the recovery and transformation of the river Buñol, from the San Luís Park to the emblematic building of the Molino Galán.

BORRUNES

The Borrunes Park or Paseo de las Delicias can be found at the foot of the Castle. It is a Difficulty: Low pleasantly welcoming place with lush vegetation, which conveys a pleasant feeling of peace and tranquillity.

EL PLANELL PARK

The Planell Park stands out for its extension. It has a large green area, a lake and sports facilities. This park can be accessed via Avda. Maestro Guzmán Cárcel.

EL ROQUILLO

A short walk from the football pitch takes us to the Roquillo Bridge, one of the first (Ask for specific information) railway bridges to be built with iron forming a curve. At its foot is the fountain and spot that gives it its name.

TURCHE CAVE

A natural site of great scenic beauty, formed by a 20-metre waterfall cascading over a lake framed by a large rock amphitheatre. It is located just 1 km. from Buñol, on the CV-425 road towards Alborache.

The starting point is the entrance to the Camino de La Jarra, at the Puente del Río Buñol, next to the Parque de San Luis. Difficulty: High / Distance: 23 km / Time: 8h.
